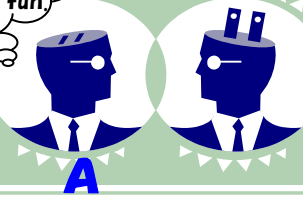

You are under arrest!!

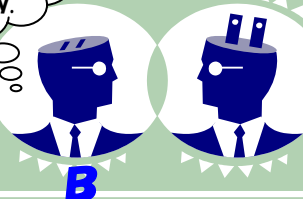


Case 2
