

Five Rules to Ride a Bicycle Safely

1. As a rule, bicycles should travel on the road. Sidewalks are exception.
2. Bicycles should travel on the left side of the road.
3. Pedestrians have the right of way over cyclists on the sidewalk. Cyclists should travel slowly on the road-side of the sidewalk.
4. Cyclists must observe the safety rules:
 - Drinking and riding, riding with two people on a single bicycle, riding a bicycle side by side are prohibited.
 - Turn on the headlight when dark.
 - Observe the traffic lights at the intersection, stop at a stop sign, confirm the safety of the situation.
5. Children must wear helmets when riding bicycles.
