




To drivers who have received suspensions



- You have accumulated the minimum points required for this suspension, so your license has been suspended.
- During the suspension period, you are not allowed to drive a car or motorcycle. **If you drive, you will be committing a crime called "driving without a license" and you could be subject to severe penalties or even have your driver's license revoked, so please do not drive during the suspension period.**
- The table below shows the basic points for administrative dispositions on driver's licenses. Administrative dispositions are determined based on the points accumulated over the past three years and the number of previous offenses, such as driver's license suspensions. When the current suspension period ends, one offense will be added to the number of previous offenses. If the number of previous offenses increases, even a small number of points may result in administrative sanctions, so please drive more carefully and safely from now on.
- If you take the suspension lecture course (fees apply), the number of days of your suspension will be reduced depending on your grade.
- The length of the training period, training content, and training fees for those who have been suspended will vary depending on the length of the suspension period (30 days, 60 days, or 90 days or more).
